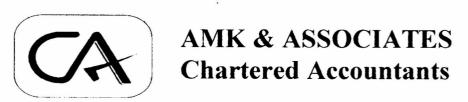

## **Limited Review Report**

We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of Jayshree Chemicals Limited ("the Company") for the Quarter and Half Year Ended 30th September, 2018 ("the statement") being submitted by the Company pursuant to requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and SEBI Circular CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 5th July, 2016. This statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors on 14th November 2018. - 4 The above standalone financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Ind AS 34 'Interim Financial Reporting' prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant Rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
- Pursuant to Section 233 of the Companies Act, 2013 the Regional Director (ER) vide his Order dated 25th October, 2018 has approved the amalgamation of Fort Gloster Electric Limited (a wholly owned subsidiary) with the Company with effect from 01.04.2017. Accordingly the financial revenue, results and assets and liabilities have been revised to give effect of the said Order with effect from 01.04.2017.
- 6 The Company has carried forward losses, therefore deferred tax assets have not been recognized in the quarter and half year ended 30,09.2018.
- 7 Exceptional items includes expenditure in connection with sale of Caustic Soda Plant to Grasim Industries Ltd.
- 8 Figures for the previous periods have been regrouped wherever necessary.
